EnduroShield was recently applied to the Mauka and Makai Towers' distinctive glass facades at the Pacific Guardian Center (PGC) in Honolulu, Hawaii. Due to the glass facade's close proximity to PGC's air conditioning cooling tower, the glass was suffering from build-up of over 20 years of heavy staining caused by runoff from the air conditioning unit onto the glass. World Wide Windows partnered with Nano Tek-On to restore and apply EnduroShield to over 30,000ft² (2,800m²) of glass.

After extensive in-field testing of numerous protective coatings, EnduroShield was chosen by PGC management to protect the restored glass against future staining and to reduce ongoing maintenance time and costs. The restoration and application of EnduroShield at PGC has resulted in glass that now looks as good as new and is much easier to clean, staying visibly cleaner for longer.
